Cofnodion o Gyfarfod o'r Cyngor a gynhaliwyd Nos Fawrth y 13eg o Ionawr 2026 am 7.00yh yn y Ganolfan, Abergynolwyn.

Presennol; Cyng. Elwyn Evans, Miriam Webb, Steve Lewis, Emrys Thompson, Gwynedd Roberts, Robert D Jones, Eleri Puw, Cyng Beth Lawton (Cyngor Gwynedd) a Huw T Jones (Clerc).

1. Estynwyd groeso cynnes i bawb gan y Cadeirydd Elwyn Evans. Roedd ymddiheuriad gan Cyng Dylan Jarman.
2. Nodwyd nad oedd cais am gyflwyniadau gan aelod o'r cyhoedd ar fater ar yr agenda.
3. **Cadarnhawyd gofnodion y cyfarfod a gynhaliwyd ar y 11eg o Dachwedd 2025** ar gynnig Cyng. Miriam Webb a'i eilio gan Cyng Steve Lewis.
4. **Aethpwyd ymlaen i groesawu Patrick Roberts a Sharon Jones, cynrychiolwyr o BCUHB i son am Ysbyty Gymunedol Tywyn.** Soniwyd am y cefndir, a rhoddwyd diweddariad am ward Dyfi, sydd wedi cau ers Ebrill 2023. Roedd 3 opsiwn gerbron, ond nid oedd penderfyniad wedi ei wneud eto am y dyfodol, ac roeddynt yn gwahodd mewnbwn. Nid oedd ail-agor y ward yn un o'r 3 opsiwn, ond dywedwyd fod hyn yn dal dan ystyriaeth.

Pwysleisiodd y Cynghorwyr mor bwysig cael buddsoddiad gan BCUHB yn yr ardal, a cheisio goresgyn y problemau er mwyn agor y ward. Dyma oedd ei angen, ac roedd rhaid gwneud mwy o ymdrech. Roedd darpariaeth rhagorol yn Tywyn, ac roedd yn bechod nad oedd yn cael ei ddefnyddio. O ran staffio, pwysleisiwyd ceisio denu rhai ifanc, cael cyswllt efo'r Brifysgol ac ysgolion etc.

Diolchwyd am gyfraniad y cynrychiolwyr a phawb, ac aethpwyd ymlaen a gweddiill y cyfarfod.

a) Materion Priffyrdd/llwybrau.

- Nodwyd lythyr gan Cyngor Gwynedd yn cadarnhau waith i cylfat Perfeddnant.

b) Safle treftadaeth / Celf Cyhoeddus – ystyriwyd y diweddaraif ynglyn a'r wagen lechi, a nodwyd fod e-bost Bet Huws o'r 2.12.25 wedi ei ddanfôn i bawb gan y Clerc 6.12.25, a nodi cyfarfod zoom 14.01.26 am 6.30yh. Hefyd e-bost 11.01.26 yn amgau papur gan Mike Christensen. Gwelwyd fod rhaid agoffa mai wagen lechi oedd y penderfyniad, a bod rhaid cadw at y penderfyniad mai y Cyngor Cymuned sydd yn cymryd y cyfrifoldeb.

c) Arwyddion y cae chwarae – byddai rhaid trafod y tro nesaf.

d) Cronfa 'Gwynedd Ni' a'r cyfle am grant o fewn ffiniau y Cyngor Cymuned. – nodwyd y diweddaraif, a diolchwyd yn fawr iawn i Gwmni Dylan Jarman a'i Feibion am waith taclus yn gosod y meinciau/byrddau a'r potiau blodau. Aethpwyd drwy y ffurflen Cwblhau Prosiect, ac ymateb i bob cwestiwn yn fanwl.

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Minutes of a Meeting of the Council held on Tuesday evening, 13 January 2026 at 7.00 pm at the Centre, Abergynolwyn

Present:

Cllr Elwyn Evans, Miriam Webb, Steve Lewis, Emrys Thompson, Gwynedd Roberts, Robert D Jones, Eleri Puw, Cllr Beth Lawton (Gwynedd Council) and Huw T Jones (Clerk).

1. Welcome

A warm welcome was extended to everyone by the Chair, Elwyn Evans. An apology was received from Cllr Dylan Jarman.

2. Public Participation

It was noted that no request had been received from a member of the public to address a matter on the agenda.

3. Minutes of the Previous Meeting

The minutes of the meeting held on 11 November 2025 were confirmed on the proposal of Miriam Webb, seconded by Steve Lewis.

4. Tywyn Community Hospital – BCUHB

Patrick Roberts and Sharon Jones, representatives of BCUHB, were welcomed to speak about Tywyn Community Hospital. Background information was provided, along with an update on Ward Dyfi, which has been closed since April 2023.

Three options were currently under consideration, but no decision had yet been made regarding the future, and input was being invited. Reopening the ward was not one of the three options, although it was stated that this was still under consideration.

Councillors emphasised the importance of securing investment from BCUHB in the area and overcoming the problems in order to reopen the ward. This was what was needed, and more effort was required. Tywyn had excellent facilities, and it was a shame that they were not being used.

With regard to staffing, the importance of attracting young people was stressed, along with developing links with the University and schools, etc.

The representatives were thanked for their contribution, and the meeting then continued.

5. Matters Arising

a) Highways / footpaths

- A letter from Gwynedd Council was noted, confirming work to the Perfeddnant culvert.

b) Heritage site / Public Art

The latest position regarding the slate wagon was considered. It was noted that an email from Bet Huws dated 2.12.25 had been circulated to all by the Clerk on 6.12.25, and that a Zoom meeting was scheduled for 14.01.26 at 6.30 pm.

An email dated 11.01.26 enclosing a paper from Mike Christensen was also noted.

It was emphasised that the decision had been for a slate wagon, and that this decision must be adhered to, with the Community Council retaining responsibility.

c) Playing field signage

This would need to be discussed at the next meeting.

d) ‘Gwynedd Ni’ Fund and grant opportunity within the Community Council boundary

The latest update was noted, and sincere thanks were extended to Dylan Jarman & Sons for their tidy work in installing the benches/tables and flower pots.

The Project Completion Form was reviewed, and all questions were answered in detail.

e) Community transport scheme

The next TAITH meeting was noted, to be held at Tywyn Library on Monday, 19 January at 11.00 am.

f) Tree on Heol y Dŵr

Tidy work carried out by Owain Williams and Arwyn Davies was noted, and thanks were expressed.

Attention was needed for trees to be cut back along the river wall, and also regarding ash dieback. Cllr Gwynedd Roberts undertook to meet with Rhydian Roberts of the National Park. The Clerk to arrange.

g) Mari Jones footpath signage

The Clerk read a response from Nerys Siddall confirming that six panels would be installed.

h) Clerk's remuneration/expenses

Following a request at the previous meeting, a letter had been prepared by the Clerk. The Clerk left the room while this matter was discussed.

It was resolved to pay a salary of £2,500 (net) and £500 in expenses from the beginning of April 2026. This would then be reviewed annually with reference to NALC pay scales.

6. Planning Matters

NP5/67/353 – Demolition of the existing band room and construction of a new single-storey band room – Abergynolwyn Band Room.

This application had been circulated, and it was confirmed that there were no objections.

7. Financial Matters

a) Reference was made to the budget agreed at the previous meeting, and it was resolved, on the proposal of Miriam Webb, seconded by Emrys Thompson, to increase the precept by £1,000 to a total of £13,600.

b) Invoices for payment

On the proposal of Miriam Webb, seconded by Robert Jones, it was agreed to pay:

- R A Davies – cutting and clearing a cherry tree – £475
- Clerk's remuneration £400.01 and HMRC £100

c) Applications for funding

- An application from Urdd Gobaith Cymru, Meirionnydd Region, was considered and, on the proposal of Emrys Thompson, seconded by Miriam Webb, a contribution of £100 was agreed. It was requested that more information be provided about Urdd activities and events in the area.
- Applications were also noted from Urdd Gobaith Cymru (Equal Opportunities Fund) and Urdd Gobaith Cymru (Anglesey Eisteddfod, May 2026), and it was decided not to contribute at this time.

8. Report of Cllr Beth Lawton (Gwynedd Council)

Cllr Beth Lawton reported on her work within the ward, including complaints about dog fouling. A request had been made for signage.

9. Report of Cllr Elwyn Evans, One Voice Wales representative

There was no report on this occasion.

10. Correspondence

a) Llanfihangel y Pennant cemetery matters

In relation to concerns that graves were being laid unevenly, Cllr Robert Jones had met with Rhys Bleddyn.

No further response had been received from Paul Inman of the Church (Bro Ystumanner area) following agreement on a cost of £320 plus VAT for the work.

b) One Voice Wales training sessions and forthcoming courses were noted, including the opportunity to undertake a number of courses free of charge.

c) Correspondence was noted regarding a gap in the wall between Ty'n Ddol and the old Ty'n y Fach bridge. Cllr Robert Jones undertook to speak with Sion Wilkes.

d) Gwynedd Council – Public Toilets Partnership Scheme

Correspondence was noted stating that the annual cost would increase from £2,000 to £2,720.

e) An email regarding Community Group Grants 2026 was noted.

f) A veterans' event organised by Liz Saville Roberts MP in Caernarfon on 7.02.26 was noted.

g) It was noted that Jason Steven Beech had been appointed to support community groups during Elin Wiliam's maternity leave.

11. Any Other Business

Deepest condolences were expressed to Eileen Jones (former Clerk) on her bereavement, and the Clerk would send a card.
