### **Cofnodion o Gyfarfod o'r Cyngor a gynhaliwyd Nos Fawrth y 14eg o Ebrill 2026 am 7.00yh yn y Ganolfan, Abergynolwyn.**

Presennol; Cyng. Elwyn Evans, Miriam Webb, Steve Lewis, Emrys Thompson, Gwynedd Roberts, Robert D Jones, a Huw T Jones (Clerc).

**1. Estynwyd groeso cynnes i bawb gan y Cadeirydd Elwyn Evans.**

Roedd ymddiheuriad gan Cyng Eleri Puw a Dylan Jarman, a Cyng Beth Lawton (Cyngor Gwynedd) .

2. Estynnwyd groeso arbennig i **Hannah Joyce a Lucy Thomas** o Gyngor Gwynedd a oedd wedi dod atom I son am brosiect y wagen lechi, ac hefyd I Gareth Jones o Ymgynghoriaeth Gwynedd a oedd yn cyfrannu ar zoom. Cafwyd cyflwyniad am y cefndir, a'r grantiau a oedd wedi eu sicrhau I lefydd eraill. Cais loteri gan LLeChiLleNi oedd hwn, ac roedd y costau wedi eu seilio ar beth roedd hyn wedi ei gostio mewn llefydd eraill. Eglurodd Gareth y gallai'r costau fod yn llai na beth a nodwyd, ond roedd rhaid rhoi amcangyfrif bras. Eglurwyd fod yr arian wedi cael ei neilltuo ar gyfer hyn, ac y byddai Cyngor Gwynedd yn gwneud y cyfan o ran talu'r anfonebau ayyb. Byddai archwiliad manwl o'r gwariant.

**4. Materion yn codi**

**a) Materion Priffyrdd/llwybrau.**

Nodwyd y diweddaraf gan Gyngor Gwynedd yng nghyswllt ymholiadau llwybrau/ffyrdd, gan gynnwys y ffordd heibio'r Ganolfan at y chwarel. Nodwyd gwynion fod ceir yn parcio bob ochr y ffordd o flaen Tafarn y Railway, ac y dylid gofyn i Gyngor Gwynedd edrych i mewn i hyn, gyda golwg rhoi llinellau melyn. Hyn yn wir hefyd am top Styrd Llanegryn.

- b) Safle treftadaeth / Celf Cyhoeddus** –ystyriwyd ymhellach y sefyllfa ynglyn a'r wagen lechi. Yn dilyn y cyflwyniad, penderfynwyd, ar gynnig Cyng Emrys Thompson a'i eilio gan Cyng Gwynedd Roberts, a gyda phleidlais y mwyafrif, i fynd ymlaen efo'r prosiect. **Minutes of a Council Meeting held on Tuesday, 14th April 2026 at 7:00pm at the Ganolfan, Abergynolwyn.**

**Present:** Cllr Elwyn Evans, Miriam Webb, Steve Lewis, Emrys Thompson, Gwynedd Roberts, Robert D Jones, and Huw T Jones (Clerk).

**1.** A warm welcome was extended to everyone by the Chairman, Elwyn Evans. Apologies were received from Cllr Eleri Puw, Dylan Jarman, and Cllr Beth Lawton (Gwynedd Council).

**2.** A special welcome was extended to Hannah Joyce and Lucy Thomas from Gwynedd Council, who had come to speak about the slate wagon project, and also to Gareth Jones from Gwynedd Consultancy, who contributed via Zoom.

A presentation was received outlining the background and grants secured in other locations. This was a lottery application by LleChiLleNi, and the costs were based on what similar projects had cost elsewhere. Gareth explained that the costs could be lower than stated, but a rough estimate had to be provided. It was explained that funding had been allocated for this, and Gwynedd Council would handle all invoice payments etc. There would be a detailed audit of expenditure.

Hannah and Lucy emphasized that it was optional for the area to accept the funding, with no

obligation. If funds remained, they could be used for something else locally. It was noted that the Community Council would be responsible for the asset after completion.

Hannah, Lucy, and Gareth were thanked and then left the meeting.

**3.** The minutes of the meeting held on 10th March 2026 were confirmed, proposed by Cllr Miriam Webb and seconded by Cllr Gwynedd Roberts.

#### **4. Matters arising**

a) **Highways/paths:** An update from Gwynedd Council was noted regarding path/road enquiries, including the road past the Centre to the quarry. Complaints were noted about cars parking on both sides of the road outside the Railway, and Gwynedd Council should be asked to investigate, with a view to installing yellow lines. This also applies to the top of Llanegryn Street.

b) **Heritage site / Public Art:** The slate wagon situation was further considered. Following the presentation, it was resolved (proposed by Cllr Emrys Thompson, seconded by Cllr Gwynedd Roberts, and carried by majority vote) to proceed with the project. It was further agreed that Cllrs Miriam Webb, Gwynedd Roberts, and Elwyn Evans would act as a Sub-Committee (with Emrys also as reserve).

c) **Tanybryn Street:** Arrangements for a site meeting were considered. It was agreed to defer this until after the election on 7th May, and in the meantime to seek assistance from a locally based barrister and consult residents of the street. Cllr Emrys Thompson agreed to take this forward.

d) **Community transport scheme:** An update was noted, including a meeting held on 30th March.

e) **Tree on Water Street:** The Clerk would ensure estimates are obtained by July.

f) **Gap in wall between Ty'n Ddol and the old Ty'n y Fach bridge:** Cllr Robert Jones agreed to deal with this.

g) **Gwynedd Council Community Support Fund:** An invitation for ideas was received again this year. Suggestions included tidying the land on the left-hand side when entering the village from the Tywyn direction, and installing a new slide in the playground.

#### **6. Financial matters**

a) Receipt of £300 from Gwynedd Council for annual footpath maintenance was noted. £130.50 had been received from Rhys Bleddyn for the reinstatement of the late R J Roberts Dysefin memorial.

Correspondence regarding the 2025–26 audit had been received, and the VAT claim had been completed totalling £2,571.20.

#### **b) Invoices to be paid:**

It was agreed (proposed by Cllr Emrys Thompson and seconded by Cllr Miriam Webb) to pay the following:

Flowers £32.33 (reimbursement to Cllr Beth Lawton).

#### **c) Funding applications:**

A request had been received from Llangollen Eisteddfod, but it was decided not to contribute.

## **7. Report from Cllr Beth Lawton (Gwynedd Council):**

Apologies received from Cllr Beth Lawton.

## **8. Report from Cllr Elwyn Evans, One Voice Wales representative:**

A Meirionnydd One Voice Wales meeting was taking place that evening, unfortunately clashing with this meeting.

Other meetings were reported on, including the Executive Committee on 13th March and the manifesto launch. There was hope for good cooperation with the Government in the future.

## **9. Correspondence**

### **a) Llanfihangel y Pennant cemetery matters:**

- A response from Paul Inman of the Church (Bro Ystumanner area) confirmed that work at the Church would be carried out soon.
- Correspondence from Rhys Bleddyn confirmed the reinstatement of the memorial to the late Robert John Roberts, Dysefin at the end of August this year.
- An email was received from Ellen Cockburn regarding burials at the cemetery, and it was noted that Gwynedd Council policies on the matter need to be clarified.
- Correspondence with Owain Williams regarding grass cutting at cemeteries and the playground noted that work would need to wait until May.

b) One Voice Wales training sessions were noted.

c) Snowdonia (Eryri) National Park Community Funds information was received, and the Clerk would distribute it.

d) An invitation to celebrate 75 years of the Talylllyn Railway was received, and the Clerk would circulate it.

e) Correspondence confirmed a ROSPA inspection of the playground again this year at a cost of £83, and this was agreed.
