- b) **Safle treftadaeth/Celf Cyhoeddus** – adroddwyd y gohebiaeth diweddaraf gan Bet Huws.

Roedd e-bost i law gan Jayne Myfanwy Mills ar ran Treftadaeth Gymunedol Abergynolwyn yn amlinellu eu cynlluniau, ac yn gofyn am gyfraniad o £200 tuag at gefnogi eu gwaith hyd nes y byddai'r ymddiriedolaeth wedi ei sicrhau cyllid eu hunain. Yn dilyn trafodaeth, penderfynwyd gadael hyn, a gofyn am dystiolaeth o'r ymddiriedolwyr wedi eu penodi, a chael mantolen fel sy'n ofynnol i'r Cyngor Cymuned cyn rhoi cyfraniadau.

(byddai y cyfanswm oddeutu £10,000) Gwelwyd y gellid cael cymorth 'Tim Tacluso' Cyngor Gwynedd i wneud gwaith o docio gwrych/tacluso a thorri coed ar y darn tir ochr chwith o'r ffordd wrth ddod i'r pentref o ochr Tywyn.

**Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the Council held on Tuesday 12 May 2026 at 7:00pm at
the Ganolfan, Abergynolwyn**

Present: Cllr Elwyn Evans, Steve Lewis, Emrys Thompson, Gwynedd Roberts, Robert D Jones, Miriam Webb, Eleri Puw, Huw T Jones (Clerk).

1. A warm welcome was extended to everyone by the Chair, Elwyn Evans.

Apologies were received from Cllr Beth Lawton (Gwynedd Council) and Cllr Dylan Jarman.

The annual report for 2025–26 was then presented by the Chair, Elwyn Evans.

He thanked everyone very much for their contributions during the year. Work had continued to ensure taxpayers' money was used responsibly and effectively.

The Council had taken advantage of “Gwynedd Ni” grants by obtaining benches, tables and flower pots in Abergynolwyn, which had enhanced the appearance of the village.

There had been extensive discussions with the Gwynedd Slate Group regarding placing a wagon in front of the Centre, and this was now progressing.

Representatives from BCUHB attended the January meeting, where the importance of investment in Tywyn Hospital and the reopening of the ward was emphasised.

The cemeteries at Llanfihangel y Pennant and Y Fedw had been kept tidy. Some trees at Y Fedw cemetery had been cut during the year.

The playground had been maintained, and arrangements made for new signs there.

Contributions had been made to local causes, and planning matters received from the National Park had been responded to.

Highways matters and footpaths generally had been dealt with, and it had been ensured that any public enquiries were answered quickly and effectively. The toilets had also been maintained.

Training opportunities had been made available for councillors if desired.

Thanks were given to all councillors and to Cllr Beth Lawton (Gwynedd Council) for her work and cooperation during the year.

2. It was noted that there had been no requests from members of the public to make presentations on agenda items.

The minutes of the meeting held on 14 April were confirmed on the proposal of Cllr Miriam Webb, seconded by Cllr Steve Lewis.

3. **Matters arising**

a) **Highways/footpath matters**

It was noted that the Council’s enquiry regarding cars parking outside the Railway pub and at the entrance to Llanegryn Street had been passed to the Traffic Unit.

b) **Heritage site/Public Art** – the latest correspondence from Bet Huws was reported.

An email had been received from Jayne Myfanwy Mills on behalf of Abergynolwyn Community Heritage outlining their plans and requesting a contribution of £200 towards supporting their work until the trust secured its own funding.

Following discussion, it was decided to defer this and request evidence that trustees had been appointed, together with financial statements as required by the Community Council before any contribution was made.

c) **Tanybryn Street** – the latest situation was discussed and would need to be considered at the next meeting. The Clerk would inform Rachel Burgess of the situation (she had attended the March meeting).

d) **Community Transport Scheme** – the latest update and minutes of 27.04.26 were noted.

e) **Community Council Support Fund** – two quotations had been received for a slide at the playground through Emrys.

It was resolved, on the proposal of Cllr Miriam Webb and seconded by Cllr Eleri Puw with unanimous support, that this would be the Council's project under the fund this year (maximum £5,500), with the remainder to come from Community Council funds. (The total cost would be approximately £10,000.)

It was noted that assistance could be obtained from Gwynedd Council's "Tidying Team" to carry out hedge trimming, tidying and tree cutting on the land to the left-hand side of the road entering the village from the Tywyn direction.

f) **Trees to be cut at the river wall near Heol y Dŵr** – members were reminded of the three names to provide quotations for carrying out this work in October this year.

g) It was reported that the cheque sent to Zurich Insurance had been lost in the post. The Clerk was in contact with the company.

Cllr Emrys Thompson agreed to cancel the cheque, and the Clerk would send another immediately.

It was also noted that progress needed to be made in updating the bank mandate and arranging online banking. This would be on the agenda for the next meeting.

4. **Planning Matters**

There were no matters to discuss.

5. **Financial Matters**

a) It was reported that the 2025–26 accounts had now been examined by the internal auditor and returned without any queries. They were formally presented to the councillors.

It was confirmed that everything was complete and ready to be passed to the external auditor in due course.

It was also noted that a public notice had been prepared for publication on the website and noticeboard.

It was further confirmed that the VAT claim for 2025–26 had been completed and £2,571.20 had been received.

h) **Invoices** – on the proposal of Cllr Emrys Thompson and seconded by Cllr Gwynedd Roberts, it was agreed to pay the following:

- Invoice from RA Davies for grass cutting at the playground and Llanfihangel y Pennant cemetery – £680.

b) **Requests for funding**

- Urdd – "Opportunity for All" Fund – it was decided not to contribute.

7. **Election of Officers 2026–27**

Chair – on the proposal of Cllr Emrys Thompson and seconded by Cllr Robert D Jones, it was unanimously agreed that Cllr Miriam Webb would serve as Chair for 2026–27.

Vice-Chair – on the proposal of Cllr Gwynedd Roberts and seconded by Cllr Emrys Thompson, it was unanimously agreed that Cllr Eleri Puw would serve as Vice-Chair for 2026–27.

8. Clerk's Salary and Terms 2026–27

It was confirmed that this had been decided on 13.01.26.

9. Confirmation of dates for the remaining Llanfihangel y Pennant Council meetings for 2026–27

It was agreed to meet on the second Tuesday of each month, except August and December, namely:

9.06.26, 14.07.26, 8.09.26, 13.10.26, 10.11.26, 12.01.27, 9.02.27 and 9.03.27.

The Clerk would place these on the Council website.

10. Forms for the register of interests were distributed for councillors to complete and were returned.

It was unanimously agreed to adopt the following:

- Financial regulations and standing orders
- Risk assessments for Llan cemetery and Y Fedw cemetery, together with the playground and the Council's financial matters (which had been distributed in advance to councillors). Changes were noted.
- Asset register – previously circulated to councillors and the figure of £19,115.00 previously confirmed, with benches, picnic tables and flower pots worth £4,600 added (total therefore £23,740).

b) One Voice Wales training sessions were noted, and the Clerk would distribute details to councillors.

c) Information regarding the “Perthyn” project for community groups was noted, and the Clerk would circulate it.

15. Any Other Business

- Sincere thanks were expressed by everyone to Cllr Elwyn Evans for his work as Chair over the past two years.
- It was agreed that the Community Council would once again run the tombola at the Abergynolwyn Carnival on the last weekend of July.
- Thanks were noted from the Ganolfan for the use of the playground for the annual fun run.
