Cytuno i godi 2 y cant, yn cael ei gynnig gan Dylan ac eilwyd gan Miriam. Pawb yn cytuno y gallwn ei gadw at hyn gan fod ein coffrau yn edrychyn weddol ac y gallwn atal codi mwy.

1. Apologies

Steve Lewis. Had a difficult day and wanted to rest. Elwyn Evans has gone down to Penarth, Cardiff to help out with family.

2. Declaration of interest – None

3. Everyone was welcomed by the Chairman. The minutes were proposed as correct by Emrys Th, Gwynedd R seconded and all agreed

4. Playground. Everything is fine

5. Cemeteries. Everything is fine

(One of the residents of the village has lost his mother and will want the ashes to be buried in the Llan, this information was noted for future reference)

6. Paths.... Invoice for £828 from Kevin Jones regarding annual path work. (Will be submitted for a refund from Gwynedd Council = £300 received last year)

7. Closed toilets. The Community Council has Received an invoice for £2000 for the last year.

It was passed that we advise Gwynedd Council that we expect improvements before paying £2000 due to the poor condition of the building.

8. Report from the chair. Ardal Llechi. The small slate plaque is in place and we are still waiting for the big sign. Passed to send the two forms back after their completion to transfer the assets to our care as a Council.

Work/Repairs have taken place at Castell y Bere.

9. Clerk's Report. Consultation on the situation and the changes to provision of the 'Air Ambulance' There is little movement on the matter. Beth Lawton has requested a consultation visit in the Tywyn area.

10. Precept. There was a discussion on the costs and how much we wanted to raise on the precept as our costs are rising, and currently the clerk's work is being done internally until someone is found. Agreed to raise by 2% proposed by Dylan and seconded by Miriam. Everyone agreed
We can keep it to this level as our reserves are looking ok.

11. Internal Audit has been completed, all is well and it has been sent to Cardiff.

We agreed to record that we have discussed the balance sheet when discussing the Precept.

Cardiff previously asked why we have so much in reserve? It was answered that we were responsible for looking after two cemeteries and a playground and needed reserve funding to purchase or repair equipment. Things would look very different if we had not received a grant of £5000

towards Playground equipment from the Coop They had also asked why line 6 was a larger figure than the previous year, and they were informed that there had been a payment received for an additional grave which was 3 instead of 2 as we had the previous year. The auditors also wanted a photo of the notice board to confirm the elected councillorsalthough there had been no change within the council.

12. Budget Report: Invoice received for work to our Web site £120 from Scott.

We need to keep track of the donations we give, as we have spent significantly without giving many donations this year.

13. Our County Councilor Beth Lawton's report: Large cuts on the horizon with Gwynedd Council facing a

£12m deficit. The council is likely to propose a 5% increase in our Council Tax
The health board had postponed a meeting and Beth expects it to have a rescheduled date.

14. Kiosks. Minffordd and Caerberllan Junction working.

15. Office of Clerk. It was noted that Huw Jones from the Mallwyd area had taken the Pennal Council clerk post. The chairman agreed to have a further chat with someone with interest as she had asked if she could have time to give up another Clerk's position before committing to Abergynolwyn.

16. One Voice. Elwyn Evans not present. Nothing to report

17. Heritage Site. Nothing extra to note, members felt the need for a meeting to drive things forward

18. Ardal Ni 2023. The council were asked if there was a demand for Welsh Language classes in the area. There are individuals attending lessons in Tywyn. The Council would Welcome anything to promote the Welsh language in any way.
