3. Acceptance of Minutes/ The minutes were received and, Gwynedd R proposed as correct with Eleri Puw seconding. All of the same opinion. The minutes were signed.

4. Talyllyn Railway, Beth has been in contact with the railway.

Report: Railway Thinking of sharing the work, "we will do as much as we can do some of the work and use external experts to do what we will not be able to do". Anna will help to look for grants when the estimate is received. The council to lead the project as they have other projects they want to do within the same grant funding.

12. Councilor Beth Lawton's report, Gwynedd Council has free tickets to disadvantaged families to visit the National Eisteddfod in Moduan

. Ysbyty Tywyn, has employed Ward Sister level 7, One level 6, and one level 5 and looking for three more to open the Ward. Minor injuries reopen on the 18th of July for them to start receiving patients on the 20th with a 'Wellbeing Clinic' starting every Thursday afternoon where different organisations will be available to discuss needs.

On the Doctors side, plenty of local locums available over the short term. Elwyn is trying to attend the 'Wellbeing' Clinic in order to report back.
